NAP ITEMS

All nap bags and bedding should adhere to MAN's non-violent and commercial-character free guidelines.

- Each nap student is provided a crib (if under 1 year) or a nap mat (if over 1 year)
- The bag of bedding is sent home for laundering each Friday.
- Please return the bedding on Monday. *(Sheets may be sent home sooner if soiled or if the student is ill. Please return them when your child returns to school.)*

PURCHASING GUIDELINES – INFANT

MAN has established the following guidelines in order to support the children in their daily endeavors, set the appropriate tone for the day and the class, and convey respect for the school community and the importance of the child's work. All students are expected to follow Montessori Academy of Naples' Dress Code and bring school items that adhere to MAN's non-violent and commercial-character free criteria (i.e. no commercial characters...cartoons, super-heroes, princesses, video game/ movie characters, etc...)

DRESS CODE

“Dress for Success” Think practical, neat, manageable, non-distracting

It is important that your child wears comfortable clothing for school. While overalls and/or and ruffles can be cute, they are often impractical for day-to-day activities.

- While we do not require a uniform, ***Wednesday is school spirit day.*** Students and staff are encouraged to wear their Montessori Academy of Naples shirts. MAN shirts may be purchased through the office.
- All clothing items must adhere to MAN's non-violent, commercial-character free guidelines.
- Clothing should be clean, neat, and properly- fitted.
- Socks and sneakers are required and should fit properly.
- Shoes must be free of adornments such as wheels, lights, attachments, etc... as well as be character-free
- We do not allow any clothing, jewelry, or other adornments that are part of a costume.
- Girls with pierced ears may wear studs. Other jewelry is discouraged as it is often distracting and can be a source of great distress if lost or damaged.
- ***Be sure to label all clothing with your child's name.***
