



Extended Primary and VPK Supply List

The following list consists of items your primary child will need for the first day of school. Please keep in mind that all clothing, shoes, and any other items for school must follow the dress code policy concerning characters and appropriate content.

All items must be clearly marked with your child's name or initials.

The school continues to limit items coming into the school. Backpacks are not necessary. If you would like to send a bag for work (optional), please purchase a canvas or cloth bag that can be laundered weekly.

LUNCH BOXES

If your child stays through lunch, and you plan to purchase a lunch box, please keep in mind that all lunch boxes and lunch box items should follow MAN's non-violent and commercial-character free guidelines. Also, all food items will need to be properly warmed and cooled within the lunch box as lunch box items will not be refrigerated or reheated at school.

- Please purchase a lunch box of standard size for classroom storage purposes.
- Please do not send any drinks from home (no water bottles, juice bags, juice boxes, sports drinks, etc...)
 - every classroom is equipped with a filtered water pitcher and students have access to filtered water throughout the day

PURCHASING CLOTHING AND OTHER ITEMS FOR SCHOOL

MAN has established the following guidelines in order to: support the children in their daily endeavors; set the appropriate tone for the day and the class; and convey respect for the school community and the importance of the child's work. All students are expected to follow Montessori Academy of Naples' Dress Code and bring school items that adhere to MAN's non-violent and commercial-character free criteria (i.e. no commercial characters...cartoons, super-heroes, princesses, video game/ movie characters, etc...)

DRESS CODE

“Dress for Success” Think practical, neat, manageable, and non-distracting.

It is important that your child can manage their clothing independently. While overalls, belts, and ruffles can be cute, they are often impractical in the restroom and can be obstructive to the child's independence.

- While we do not require a uniform, ***Wednesday is school spirit day.*** Students and staff are encouraged to wear their Montessori Academy of Naples shirts. MAN shirts may be purchased through the office.
- All clothing items must adhere to MAN's non-violent, commercial-character free guidelines.
- Clothing should be clean, neat, and properly- fitted.
- Socks and sneakers are required and should fit properly.
- Shoes must be free of adornments such as wheels, lights, attachments, etc... as well as be character-free
- We do not allow any clothing, jewelry, or other adornments that are part of a costume.
- Girls with pierced ears may wear studs. Other jewelry is discouraged as it is often distracting and can be a source of great distress if lost or damaged.
- **Be sure to label all clothing with your child's name.**
